Swords and such have since become more about ceremony than survival.

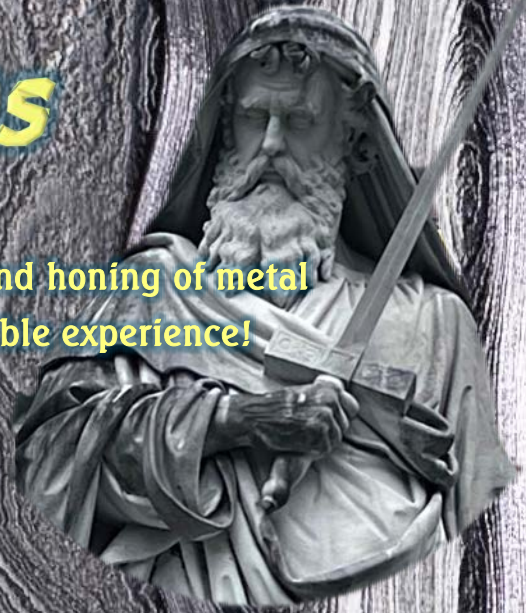
Yet back in the days when your life might swing on the strength of your steel, sword design was a vital craft.
